**Cost-recovery fees charged to researchers for the reproduction of archival materials assist in long-term preservation of historical records in the Permanent Collection of the Provincial Archives of Saskatchewan.**

## 23. Commercial Use Fee

\$25.00 / item

The per-item commercial use fee will be charged for the use of Reproductions of Archival Records for commercial use in the following ways, in addition to reproduction and shipping fees:

- Standard print or CD / DVD publication (books, periodicals, CDs, DVDs);
- Online publications that are pay-per-view or by paid subscription;
- Posters for commercial sale;
- Website use for commercial enterprises (commercial display, commercial advertising, etc.)
- Non-Broadcast Advertising (for example, printed advertisements);
- Commercial display purposes (stores, hotels, restaurants, etc.);
- Still Reproductions of Archival Records used in a commercial broadcast;

Commercial Use Fee Exceptions: Commercial Use Fees will not be charged in the following circumstances, although reproduction and shipping fees may still apply:

- Educational Use: non-commercial, not-for-profit educational publications and products;
- Non-Commercial Use: non-commercial, not-for-profit publications, including not-for profit family history books, local history books, etc.;
- Personal Use: research or private study, or other non-commercial, not-for-profit personal uses
- Television and Newspaper Media Use: for one-time use, i.e. for use related to a current news story; requires on-screen or printed credit to the Archives; related stories on television station or newspaper websites also require caption information and citation, with credit to the Archives.
- Website Use: non-commercial uses as listed above, with a maximum of 600 x 600 pixels at 96 dpi resolution (unless otherwise authorized by the Archives); use requires appropriate captions and citations, including credit to the Archives.

## 24. Commercial Broadcasting Use Fee

Video / film

\$100.00 / minute  
(30 sec. minimum charge)

Sound recordings

\$100.00 / minute  
(30 sec. minimum charge)

A per-item Commercial Broadcasting Use Fee will be charged for the use of Reproductions of Archival Records for commercial broadcast use, in addition to reproduction and shipping fees:

- for network television stations (CBC, CTV, Global, Shaw, etc.) or commercial radio stations that are using archival film/video footage, sound recordings, photographic stills or reproductions of other archival documents when creating original films/videos such as documentaries or movies, commercial broadcast advertising, or other non-news-related programming,
- for commercial film/video makers working on documentaries, movies, commercial advertising, etc.

Commercial Broadcasting Use Fee Exceptions: Commercial broadcasting use fees will not be charged under the following circumstances, although reproduction and shipping fees may still apply:

- donors will not be charged commercial broadcasting fees to broadcast items from records that they have donated to the Archives;
- television or radio news broadcasts: there will be no charge for one-time use, for example for use related to a current news story.

## 25. Merchandise Use Fees

Negotiable based on item and intended use

A per-item Merchandise Use Fee will be charged for the use of Reproductions of Archival Records to produce commercial merchandise, for example: mugs, bottles, t-shirts, calendars, posters, key rings, commemorative plates or spoons, mouse pads, etc.
